

March 2, 1915

Le Sahag Khabagau^{at Adana} reported to Hareu Patriarch Yeghiagau at Constantinople that order was issued to deport all Armenians of Zeitun as a punishment for 25 deserters.¹

In his naivety the Catholicos dispatched a telegram to the Armenian Pastor in Zeitun to invite the 25 deserters to give up and surrender in order to save the population from deportations.

December 6-7, 1914

Ahmed Bey, commanding 160 gendarmes, and
Sherif Bey, head of Shikak tribe, commanding
150 Hamidië, encircled Bashkaley. They pillaged
and burned Armenian houses, killed Armenian
men, raped Armenian women and girls.

They gathered the Armenians of the villages
Paz, Arak, Pis, Alalieu, Alas, Siran, Rasulan,
Arak, a total of 1600 men, women and children,
and massacred them. 1
