Environmental School

Students in the Environmental School satisfy Clark's liberal arts requirements and enhance studies in their major by taking 10 courses that focus on interactions between the environment and humankind. These include core curriculum courses in the humanities, sciences and social sciences, as well as advanced studies within their major.

International Studies Stream

Students in the International Studies Stream fulfill Clark's broad liberal arts requirements by taking a set of courses with an international theme. They also satisfy an enhanced language proficiency requirement and participate in a study-abroad program or undertake an internship with an international focus.

Latin Honors

Latin honors are awarded at three ascending levels: *cum laude*, *magna cum laude* and *summa cum laude*. These general honors are determined by criteria such as GPA and percentage of courses taken on a graded basis.

Commencement Notes

Clark University was founded in 1887 as the first all-graduate institution in America; the undergraduate college was established in 1902. During the early years of the University, graduate degrees were awarded on an individual basis. Formal commencement exercises began at Clark in June 1905, when bachelor's degrees were awarded for the first time.

From the cap, gown and hood, it is possible to distinguish the institution from which the wearer graduated, the field of learning in which his or her degree was earned and the level of degree: bachelor's, master's, or doctor's.

The distinguishing feature of the black mortarboard cap, standard at most colleges and universities in the United States, is the color of the tassel—black for the holder of bachelor's or master's degrees, gold for doctor's degrees and the governing officers of educational institutions.

The gown is normally black, although the chief officers of many universities wear colored gowns, and several institutions have authorized optional doctoral gowns that embody the institution's colors. The level of degree is indicated by the gown's cut. The bachelor's gown, which is relatively simple, has long pointed sleeves. The master's gown is somewhat fuller, and its sleeves, which reach nearly to the wearer's knees, are squared at the ends. The gown for the doctor's degree is cut rather fully. It has velvet panels down the front and around the neck, and bell-shaped sleeves decorated with three horizontal velvet bars.

The hood is the most distinctive feature of the academic attire in the United States. Originally used as a cowl, a shoulder cape and a container in which to collect alms, the hood is now worn at the back, suspended from the shoulders. The length of the hood and width of the velvet border indicate the level of the degree held. The length of the bachelor's hood is four feet long, and the border is five inches wide. The hood is lined with the official color or colors of the institution conferring the degree, and the color of the border indicates the field of learning in which the degree is earned.

The gowns worn by the doctoral candidates were designed and first worn in 1991 to commemorate the 100th anniversary of the awarding of the first Ph.D. at Clark. The robes are emerald green with gold University seals on the lapels. These complement the traditional doctoral hoods, reflecting the University's official colors, white and emerald.

Today's Commencement also features the flags of 61 nations and the United Nations, lining the walkway of the processional. These flags represent the homelands of all undergraduate and graduate degree recipients. With students from 79 countries in attendance at Clark and members of the faculty involved in research, training and development around the world, Clark's international character is evident and is honored today with this display.

Honorary Degree Recipients

Amartya Sen is a scholar from India whose work on welfare has produced a new understanding of the catastrophes that plague society's poor. He was awarded the 1998 Nobel Prize in Economics for his contributions to welfare economics. Helping the world understand what causes famine and how the poorest are treated in society, his work ranges from the theory of social choice through definitions of welfare and poverty, to studies of famine and how resources are distributed to the poorest members of society. Sen is Master of Trinity College, Cambridge, United Kingdom, and Lamont University Professor Emeritus at Harvard University. Born in Santiniketan, India, he earned a B.A. from Presidency College, Calcutta, India and B.A., H.A. and Ph.D. degrees from Trinity College, Cambridge. He joined Trinity College in 1998 after teaching at Harvard, Oxford, the London School of Economics, Delhi School of Economics and Jadavpur University. He is honorary president of OXFAM and has served as president of the Econometric Society, the Indian Economic Association, the American Economic Association and the International Economic Association. He has received honorary doctorates from many major universities in North America, Europe and Asia. In addition to his Nobel Prize, Sen has received numerous awards among which are the "Bharat Ratna" (the highest honor awarded by the President of India), the Alan Shawn Feinstein World Hunger Award, and the Edinburgh and Eisenhower medals. He will receive the doctor of science degree.

Gerald N. Grob is the Henry E. Sigerist Professor of the History of Medicine, Emeritus, at Rutgers University and a leading historian of health, medicine and mental health in the United States. He earned a B.S.S. from City College of New York, an A.M. from Columbia University and a Ph.D. from Northwestern University. An exemplary scholar whose works have become classics in the field, Grob taught at Clark from 1957 to 1969, where he rose from instructor to professor and chair of the History Department. While at Clark, he published "The State of the Mentally Ill – A History of Worcester State Hospital, 1830-1920," a groundbreaking work that won the American Association of State and Local History's national prize in 1965. In 1969, Grob became chair of the History Department at Rutgers University. Many of his books, including "Mental Illness and American Psychiatry 1875-1940," "From Asylum to Community: Mental Health Policy in Modern America" and his study of Edward Jarvis, are regarded as definitive sources in the field of the history of mental health. Among his many awards and honors are the American Association for the History of Medicine's William H. Welch Gold Medal, two National Endowment for the Humanities fellowships, a Guggenheim fellowship and election to the Institute of Medicine and the National Academy of Sciences. He will receive the doctor of letters degree.

John P. Holdren is the Teresa and John Heinz Professor of Environmental Policy and director of the Program on Science, Technology and Public Policy at the John F. Kennedy School of Government, and professor of science and policy in the Department of Earth and Planetary Sciences at Harvard University. Trained in aeronautics/astronautics and plasma physics, he holds B.A. and M.A. degrees from the Massachusetts Institute of Technology and a Ph.D. from Stanford University. Until 1996, he was professor in the University of California at Berkeley's campuswide interdisciplinary graduate program in Energy and Resources, which he established in 1973 and co-directed for 23 years. He was chair of the Committee on International Security and Arms Control of the National Academy of Sciences and was a member of former President Clinton's Committee of
